PAYMENT GATEWAY

Levying of Fees

The Immigration online payment fees are levied by the Solomon Islands Immigration Division, that must be paid for each visa application. In some circumstances the fees may be \$0 or exempted. The base Immigration application fees are in US Dollars (USD) and levied then converted into Solomon Islands Dollars (SBD). For applications made online, the Immigration fee is levied in Solomon Islands (SBD) at the published exchange rate to the USD rate. Conversion rates, the base USD and the total levied SBD amount will be provided upon entry to the payment screen on your visa application.

IMMIGRATION ACT 2012

(No. 3 of 2012)

IMMIGRATION (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025

I, Hon. Jaimie Lency Vokia, Minister for Commerce, Industry, Labour and Immigration, under section 93 of the Immigration Act 2012 (No. 3 of 2012), make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2025.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on a date appointed by the Minister by notice published in the Gazette.

3 Regulations amended

These Regulations amend the Immigration (Fees) Regulations 2013 (the “Principal Regulations”) (Legal Notice No. 111 of 2013).

4 Regulation 3 amended



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The Principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 3 and substituting the following:

“3 Visa Classes and Applicable Administration Fees

(1) In accordance with section 20(2) of Immigration Act 2012, different fees are prescribed for visa classes and subclasses in different circumstances, including:

- (a) at the time of application; and
- (b) at the time of visa extension.

(2) The prescribed fees are set out in Schedule 1.”

5 Regulation 5 amended

The Principal Regulations are amended by repealing regulation 5 and substituting the following:

“5 Conversion fee

Schedule 2 has effect for the purposes of section 20(1) of the Act.”

6 New Regulation 9 inserted

The Principal Regulations are amended by inserting after regulation 8:

“9 Mode of application and payment

(1) The application process and the payment of fees under these Regulations shall primarily be conducted through electronic means as determined by the Solomon Islands Immigration Division.

(2) Despite sub regulation (1), the Immigration Division may allow manual application and payment processes in exceptional circumstances, including but not limited to:

- (a) system outages or technical failures; or
- (b) applicants with limited access to electronic platforms; or
- (c) other circumstances as determined by the Director of Immigration.”
